Maha Sarakham Museum displays the unique way of life of Maha Sarakham people that represents a combination of the way of the urban community and the way of the rural community. Consequently, it creates a way of life that is "unique" for the people of Maha Sarakham who live in peace and simplicity along with building strength in social and cultural aspects. On August 22, 1865, King Rama IV graciously ordered Ban Lat Kut Yang Yai or Nang Yai to be Muang Maha Sarakham

City by appointing Thao Mahachai as Phra Charoen Ratchadej, the governor of the city, who protected the city of Muang Maha Sarakham under the governane of Muang Roi Et.
