

Curved building: a market in 1957

Built in 1962, the curved building was considered a modern commercial building during that period. On the top of the building was the Thai Prakong Hotel and below were government offices, a sanatorium, a bus terminal, and a pawn shop. It was surrounded by a fresh market called Talad Rao (moved from Charoen market in the 1930s by Mr. Huat Thongroj, the mayor). Currently, the curved building is a shop among other surrounding shops located in the Maha Sarakham Market.
