

Nakhon Sawan Road: the main road of Muang Maha Sarakahm

Nakhon Sawan Road is the main road starting at Maha Sarakham University (original location) that cuts through the center of Muang Maha Sarakham to the area of Ban Song Nang Yai. The road was named in honor of His Royal Highness Prince Boribhat Sukhumbhand Krom Phra Nakhon Sawan Woraphinit, the son of King Chulalongkorn the Great (Rama V), when he travelled by helicopter from Nakhon Ratchasima Province to Maha Sarakham Province (currently the area of Sutthawet Hospital, Faculty of Medicine, Maha Sarakham University) and traveled by royal car along this road to the Provincial Hall and proceeded to Roi Et Province.
